

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ROYAL LONDON ROULETTE & SIGNED BAT COMPETITION

1. The “Promoter” is The Royal London Mutual Insurance Society Limited, a company incorporated in England and Wales (company number 99064) and having its registered office at 55 Gracechurch Street, London, EC3V 0RL.
2. By entering this prize draw (the “**draw**”) entrants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions and any other requirement set out in the material relating to this promotion.
3. This draw is only open to people who are resident in the UK and over the age of 18. Automated entries, bulk entries or third party entries will be disqualified.
4. Entrants must not be an employee or contractor of the Promoter or any subsidiary of the Promoter or be in any other way connected with this draw (including relatives of any such person).
5. Entry to the draw is free and there is no requirement to purchase any products from the Promoter. Entries may be made by sharing a photo or video of their match day experience of a Royal London One-Day International Match in accordance with clause 7 with the hashtag “#RoyallondonCricket” via Twitter or Instagram only.

7. There will be two prize draws made available to enter on each of the following days: 13 June 2018, 16 June 2018, 19 June 2018, 21 June 2018, 24 June 2018, 12 July 2018 and 17 July 2018 (each a ‘Match Day’).
 - Both prize draws will open for entries on each Match Day at 9.00.
 - Entrance to the first prize draw will close at the start of the interval on the same Match Day. This will be when the last ball has been bowled of the first 50 overs or when all of the batting side have been dismissed. Once entries to the first prize draw are closed 3 winners will be drawn on each Match Day. Each winner of this draw will be given one of the following prizes: signed England Team cricket bat, signed official England ODI snap cap, official England training media polo shirt, a pair of Royal London cricket bat socks or a Royal London ‘Gilbert’ soft toy. Prizes are allocated by the Promoter and the winner is not able to select the prize.
 - Entrance to the second prize draw will close at 16.00 on each Match Day. Once entries to the second prize draw are closed 1 winner will be drawn. The winner will win a signed England Team cricket bat.

We may require proof of eligibility prior to awarding any prize.
10. We cannot be responsible for invalid details or communication failures. If any winner is not contactable after we have made reasonable efforts to do so (or is deemed ineligible in accordance with the terms) or does not provide their details no other winner will be drawn.
11. Each prize is non-transferable, and no cash alternative will be offered. If for any reason we cannot provide the prize, we will offer an alternative prize of similar value. We will not be responsible for any damage to the prize on and during delivery as we rely on third parties for deliver.
12. Your prize will be sent to you via Royal Mail recorded delivery and a signature will be required on delivery. The prize will be sent out for delivery within 2 months of the winner being selected, pending the delivery of the prize to the distributor.
13. The number of prizes to be given away per match will be determined by play and the time allocated for the Royal London Roulette prize draw. Should there be a change in scheduling which results in no draws being able to take place, no prizes will be given away at that match.

14. In the event of unforeseen circumstances making the administration of the competition impossible or impractical, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel the draw. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss whatsoever as a result of cancellation of the draw.
15. The Promoter reserves the right to vary the prize without prior notice to an alternative prize of equal or greater value. No cash alternative shall be available.
16. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse to award the prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.
17. By accepting the prizes, the winners will co-operate with any publicity activity associated with the draw, where reasonably requested by the Promoter, and agrees that the Promoter may disclose the winner's name and county of residence on the Promoter's website.
18. Statistical data collected from the entries submitted may be used in subsequent marketing material by the Promoter but will only be used on an anonymous basis.
